### **Utah's Push for Control over Federal Lands Continues**

Despite the U.S. Supreme Court's refusal to hear Utah's original lawsuit—and the removal of a proposed land sale amendment from a broader legislative package—state leaders remain undeterred.

## What to watch for:

#### **Renewed Legal Action**

Although the Supreme Court declined to hear Utah's case, the state can still refile in a lower federal court or pursue new lawsuits aimed at gaining control over federal land.

#### **Legislative Strategy**

In 2005, Utah created the Public Lands Policy Coordinating Office, tasked with implementing the state's public land priorities and influencing decisions at all levels of government. Expect further attempts to insert land transfer language into unrelated congressional bills or pass new state laws undermining federal control.

#### **Misinformation Campaign**

In 2024, Utah launched a \$2 million taxpayer-funded PR effort, Stand for Our Land—Let Utah Manage Utah Land intended to spread misleading narratives through newspaper ads, billboards, TV, and social media, both locally and nationally. Outreach targeted Washington, D.C. officials, national media, and public opinion.

### **Influencing Federal Policy**

Utah officials are lobbying Congress to shift federal land management policies in the state's favor—by partnering with aligned lawmakers, advocating for national-level policy changes, and challenging federal land agency decisions.
